ACTIVITIES

FINE-MOTOR

- Circle Drawing – Have kids trace or draw circles on paper.
- Circle Cutting Practice – Help children cut circles from construction paper.
- Play Dough Circles – Roll out dough and cut out circles using cookie cutters.
- Bowl Tracing – Trace around bowls or lids to make perfect circles.
- Circle Rubbings – Put circular objects under paper and rub with crayons.
- Circle Sticker Art – Use colorful circle stickers to create patterns.
- Circle Pasta Necklace – Thread round pasta onto a string to make a necklace.

GROSS-MOTOR

- Hula Hoop Jump – Lay hula hoops on the floor, and kids jump from one to another.
- Circle Dance – Have children form a circle and move around while holding hands.
- Rolling Circles – Roll circular objects like balls or wheels down ramps.
- Circle Pattern Hop – Jump between circles in a specific pattern.
- Parachute Circles – Use a parachute and have kids create waves or shake balls in the center.
- Musical Circles – Similar to musical chairs, lay out hula hoops or circular mats for kids to stand in when the music stops.
- Pass the Ball in a Circle – Stand in a large circle and pass a ball around as quickly as possible, adding speed and direction changes.

MATH

- Circle Hunt – Look for and collect circular objects around the classroom.
- Circle Stacking – Stack circular blocks or objects.
- Circle Counting Mat – Use a mat with circles to count small items.
- Circle Shape Sort – Sort colorful circle cutouts by color.
- Sort Round Things – Sort items that are round, like balls, lids, or buttons.
- Sort by Size – Gather circular objects of different sizes (like lids or cutouts), and have kids sort them from smallest to largest.
- Circle Patterns – Create simple patterns with colored circle stickers or cutouts.

CREATIVE

- Circle Stamping – Use circular objects like bottle caps dipped in paint.
- Bubble Wrap Circles – Cut bubble wrap into circles and use it to stamp paint.
- Make a Circle Collage – Glue circles of different sizes onto a larger paper.
- Pom-Pom Circle Art – Glue small circular pom-poms into a design.
- Marble Art in Circles – Roll marbles dipped in paint around in a tray.
- Bubble Blowing Art – Blow bubbles with paint onto paper circles, and let them pop to leave colorful, circular marks.
- Circular Sticker Resist – Place stickers paper, paint over it, then remove the stickers to reveal a unique design.
